NOVEMBER Celebrating 10 years of Global Entrepreneurship



The two-day celebrations of the Millennium Global Entrepreneurship Week MGEW 2017, an undertaking to commemorate startup innovators and job creators, commenced with a Start-up Idea Competition at the Millennium University College Islamabad.

During one week each November, GEW inspires people everywhere through local, national and global activities designed to help them explore their potential as self-starters and innovators. These activities, from large scale competitions and events to intimate networking gatherings, connect participants to potential collaborators, mentors and even investors-introducing those to new possibilities and exciting opportunities.

This year TMUC collaborated with the Hult Prize, world's foremost platform for the creation and launch of for-good, for-profit startups, to organize a start-up Idea Pitching Competition wherein youth from TMUC Nationwide campuses gathered at The Millennium University College Islamabad to present their innovative and creative ideas.

Student teams were faced with the challenge not to invent the energy systems of the future but to deploy them at scale by listening closely to

customer needs, designing scalable business models, and executing plans that are capable of transforming the lives of 10 million people by 2025 through the use of energy.

The competition comprised a preliminary round where from six out of 16 participating teams qualified for the final round.

The Hult Prize Business Idea Competition was won by Team Recycled Charge who pitched their Idea on harnessing waste energy through recycling. The judges for the final round included Mr Noman Azhar (Country Head- Branchless Banking JS Bank), Ms Samar Hassan (founder Epiphany Launchpad), Mr Noshad Khalid Minhas (Head of Cash Management and Projects Silk Bank), Mr Hassan Zulfiqar (Co-Director of Start Up Grind), Mr Mustafa Minhas (Director Admin & Finance at Iqra University), Mr. Ahad Wazir (associate at Team-up).

This winning team shall now move onto the Hult Prize Regional contests happening in 15 cities around the world including, Boston, San Francisco, London, Shanghai, Dubai & other destinations. The event was sponsored by TopCity-1 one of Pakistan's largest real estate investment firm in Pakistan, and Paragon City PVT Ltd, Amish Marbles and Saad Zia photography.

The Law and Moot Society under the patronage of Ms Hiba Saigal (Programme Manager Laws) at TMUC Karachi held a mock trial session on the 21st October 2017. The honourable ladyships were Ms Hiba Saigal and Ms Anza Saqib, and the verdict was passed by a jury selected from among the student body. This was a unique opportunity for the students to get practical, hands on exposure about the legal profession, on making memorials, arguing on points of law, questioning witnesses and legal research and drafting. The case was R v Tube, where the accused, a plumber was charged with murder of the deceased, a 73 year old lady. Both the Prosecution and the Defendants presented their arguments well. However, for the lack of "mens rea" relevant intention to kill, the jury passed a unanimous verdict whereby the accused was found not guilty.

The event was inaugurated by Principal Tehmina Khalid wherein she expressed the need to engage the youth of Pakistan in such organized events and foster team work.




