<p align="center"><b>IFP</b> International Foundation Program</p>	<p>Normally be aged 17 or over before December in the year of registration and should have passes in a minimum of at least four separate subjects at GCSE/GCE O level, with grades A-C (sometimes a combination of O-levels, As, A-levels is accepted if the candidate does not meet the given O-level criteria) or the equivalent in Intermediate, Matriculation, AS Level and have acceptable examinations equivalent to GCSE/GCE O level English language at grade C or above or demonstrated fluency in academic English (for example, a test of proficiency in English such as IELTS at 5.5 band overall). Year 12 Pakistani schooling will require 4 separate subjects passed at 50% or above. If schooling is not taught in the medium of English then in addition they will require an acceptable proficiency test in English (such as IELTS) or Year 10 Pakistani schooling will require an average of at least 80% from all subjects taken. <p align="center"><b>CHES</b> Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences</p>	<p>Age Requirements: Students should normally be aged 18 or above before 31 December in the year they first register Entrance qualifications: One GCE/A level (As, or equivalent) and 4 GCSE/O levels (or equivalent as set out in the Qualifications for Entrance PDF on the International Programmes website) including Mathematics OR Six GCSE/O levels (or equivalent) including Mathematics requirements: GCSE/O level Math with a grade C or above or English language proficiency: IELTS (with a minimum of 5.5 in each sub-test) or equivalent, as set out on the International Programmes website (sometimes a combination of O-levels, A-levels and As level is accepted if the candidate does not meet the given O-level criteria) Year 12 Pakistani schooling will require 6 separate subjects passed at 50% or above, including Math. If Math is not passed at 50% or above then we will accept year 10 Math passed at 80% or above. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>CertHE</b> Certificate of Higher Education in Common Law</p>	<p>To be eligible to register for the CertHE applicants must normally be 18 years of age by 1 September in the year of registration (students below this age may be considered on an individual basis by the University but this would be subject to the applicant demonstrating a strong performance at Year 12).</p> <p>One GCE/A level (2 As or equivalent) and 4 GCSE/O-levels (or equivalent as set out in the Qualifications for Entrance PDF on the International Programmes website)</p> <p>English language proficiency: A C-grade in O level English or IELTS (with a minimum of 5.5 in each sub-test) or equivalent, as set out on the International Programmes website (sometimes a combination of O-levels, A-levels and As level is accepted if the candidate does not meet the given O-level criteria)</p> <p>As part of the selection process applicants must sit and successfully pass the online Admission Test devised by the University and also be interviewed by a senior member of TMUC's teaching team. <p><b>BSc Honors</b> 3 years</p>	<p>To be eligible for the standard Route you must: Normally be at least 17 years old and Must have passes in either: Two subjects at GCSE/GCE A-Level at Grade A-E, or three subjects in GCE O-Level Grades A-C and meet the General Entrance Requirements competence in Mathematics at least equivalent to GCSE/GCE O-level at Grade C or above and provide proof of competence in English (Grade C or above) which is acceptable to the University. A test of proficiency may be required. (Note: In addition to the above criteria the admission officer can write to UoL UK admission office for the following cases too if they meet English and Math requirements three subjects at GCE A-Level (with one not less than D) and one further subject at GCSE/GCE O-Level at Grade C or above; or two subjects at GCE A-Level plus two further subjects at GCE AS Level and one further subject at GCSE/GCE O-Level at Grade C or above; or one subjects at GCE A-Level plus two further subjects at GCE AS Level and one further subject at GCSE/GCE O-Level at Grade C or above.</p>	<p>January - September every year</p>
<p><b>LLB</b> 3 years</p>	<p>To satisfy the entrance requirements for the LLB (and for Individual Modules) you must: Normally* be aged 17 or above by 30th November in the year of registration and satisfy the University's General Entrance Requirements. Must have passes in either: Two subjects at GCSE/GCE A-Level at Grade A-E, or four subjects in GCE O-Level Grades A-C and provide proof of competence in English (Grade C or above) which is acceptable to the University. A test of proficiency may be required.</p> <p>*Applications will be considered from applicants who do not meet the normal minimum age requirement for admission. Each application will be considered on an individual basis, and the decision will be at the discretion of the University of London. Route 2: Graduates holding an undergraduate degree from an acceptable university in Pakistan which is at least of four-year duration.</p>	<p>January - September every year</p>
